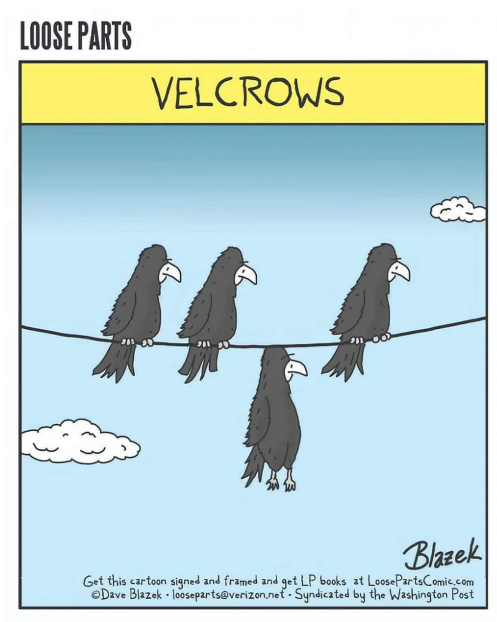

Founding and Round A1 (2020/2021)

- \$45,000 raised from 9 members

Round A2 (2022)

- \$70,000 raised from 14 members

Round B (mid-2022)

- \$385,000 from ~77 members

2022 (Round A2) Budget: \$70,000 | Spent YTD: \$17.4k

- Tech (Platform Development) \$30K-\$40K | \$10k
 - Back-end Dev- \$20K
 - Front-end Dev - \$5K
 - Tech Writer - \$5K
- Governance (Legal/Accounting) \$10K
- Operations/Facilitator \$10K | \$5k
- Reserve \$10K-20K
- Overhead ~\$6k year | \$2.4k

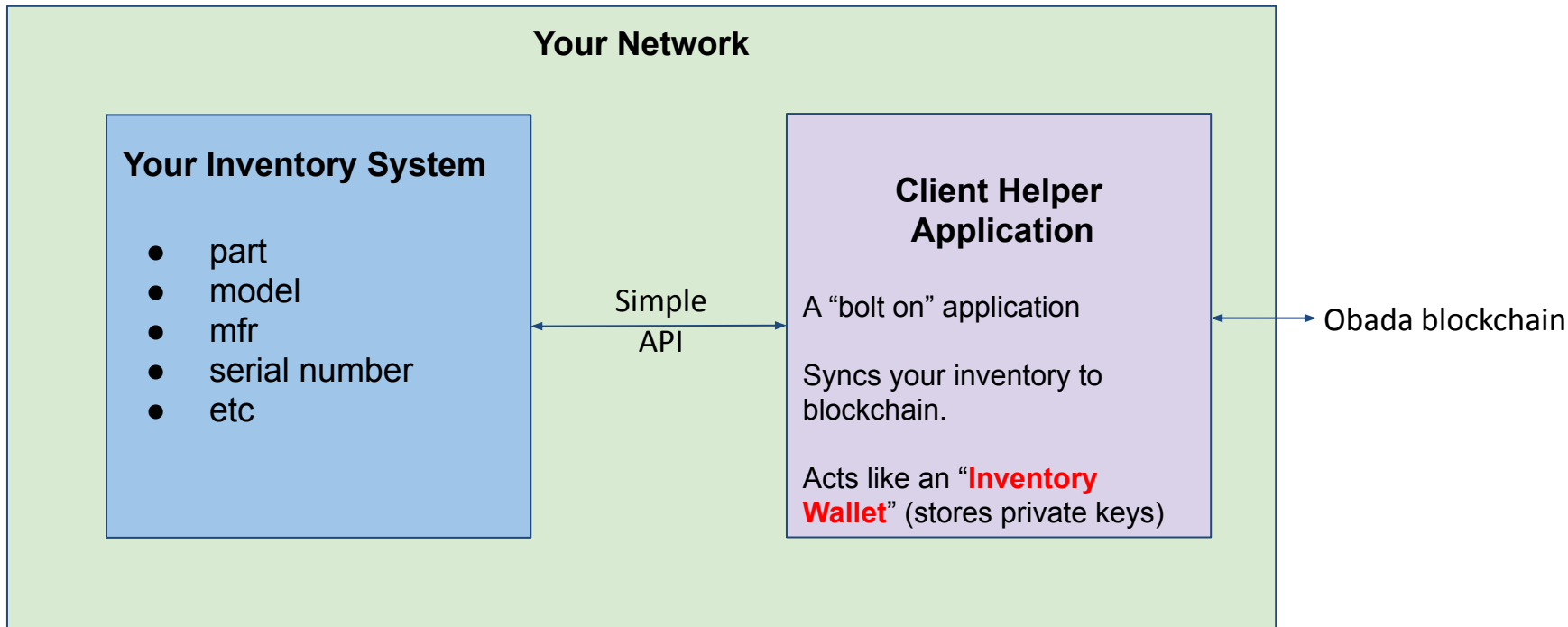

ISO Update: The pNFT Standard: Proposed Scope

This document defines the pNFT as a physical asset represented by a non-fungible token (NFT) by establishing an open, blockchain-agnostic architecture which includes:

- An algorithmic data model for generating decentralized identifiers based on immutable physical asset identifiers.
- The use of trust anchor processes based on verified credentials, to establish real-world proofs of human and machine generated information.
- A decentralized identifier (DID) method for storing and transferring the digital representation, and for utilizing it as a primitive NFT component to enable pNFTs.

This document is applicable to...

- Systems, machines, and natural persons that record or store information about serialized physical assets.

This document is not applicable to (does not include)..

- The decentralized identifier generation model is only for serialized physical assets. It does not enable digital NFTs, fungible assets, or non-serialized non-fungible physical assets.
- The trust anchor processes establish a general framework for using verified credentials, but leaves the specific mechanisms to the implementers.
- The DID method defines standard interactions to enable interoperability but it is blockchain agnostic. It does specify the use of any specific DLT protocol or NFT implementation.
